RE2 ROAD: Illegal structures to be razed

Structures and encroachments obstructing the construction of the RE2 road to be constructed from Bhuri Tekri to Nayta Mundla will be razed and removed as per instruction from the municipal commissioner on Friday during an inspection of the entire path on which the road will be constructed. Commissioner Harshika Singh inspected the under construction RE2 road from Bhuri Tekri to Nayta Mundla. Along with this, the under construction road from Bengali Square to Bhuri Tekri was also inspected by commissioner Singh. She inspected the road near GRP Police Line located in Bhuri Tekri area to Pilyahana Bicholi Kankad, Shanti Nagar, Shiv Nagar, Shivdarshan Nagar, Scheme No 140 and other areas. Commissioner Singh instructed that the obstruction in construction of RE2 road from GRP Police Line near Bhuri Tekri to

Revenue Nagar Colony must be removed. After taking detailed information regarding RE 2 Road from concerned officers, the commissioner inspected the RE 2 Road.

While discussing with residents living in slums located in Bicholi Kankad area, the commissioner took information regarding the houses allotted under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Instructions were given to officials to begin shifting people who have been allotted with houses.

It may be noted that under Indore Development Plan 2021, the main road RE 2 is from Bhuri Tekri via Nemawar Road to RTO Nayta Mundla. The length of the road being constructed is 4.25 km and its width is 45 metres. The cost of the project is approximately Rs 42.16 crore. The construction of RE 2 will provide direct connectivity to nearby colonies to RTO, ISBT and bypass and will reduce traffic pressure on other connecting roads of the city.

Bridge to come up on Saraswati River at Harsiddhi

To attract visitors and provide an alternate way to reach Harsiddhi Smart Park developed by Indore Smart City Development Limited, a bridge is being built from Moti Tabela side. The bridge is being built completely with metal and iron and would be ready in the coming days.

A beautiful bridge for pedestrians and a stop dam will also be built in the future. Smart City spends around Rs 4 crore on this project. The bridge will be 40 to 50 metres long and 5 metres wide. A stop dam about two metre high will be built below it.

Beautiful lights and fountains will be installed around the bridge and at

the stop dam. Construction of the bridge will provide additional access to the garden. With these development works, a garden and pleasant place will be developed in the central area of the city.

After completing the development work, there is a plan to run boat ride in Harsiddhi area of

Saraswati River, officials said. The boat will run in about 400 metres between Harsiddhi Bridge and stop dam. The design, lighting, waterfall and fountains of the composite bridge will be the centre of attraction. For the convenience of people, a parking facility will also be made on the outer end of the bridge.

LS polls: AICC seeks more names, holds screening committee meeting

Patwari and Singhar lobbying for ticket

Bhopal: AICC has sought more names to finalise their list of candidates for the general elections. In a LS poll screening committee meeting held in New Delhi on Friday, the AICC asked the parliamentary in-charges to look for more suitable candidates. The party has appointed parliamentary in-charges to look for a suitable candidate for their respective constituency. Sources said that AICC is not satisfied with the names submitted to it and wants more suitable candidates for the elections. Earlier, they had submitted a panel to the PCC and also to AICC office bearers who have been made in-charge of the state like Jitendra Singh and others. Sources said that newly appointed party state president Jitu Patwari and LoP Umang Singhar are lobbying to get a ticket for the Lok Sabha elections.

Illegal sand mining rocks state Assembly

40 electronic barriers being constructed to check menace

The issue of illegal sand mining rocked the assembly during the question hour on Friday.

The Opposition members expressed concern over illegal sand mining and demanded that the state government take strict action to control the situation.

MLA Suresh Rajee had raised the issue in Dabra Bhitwar area. He opined that excavation of sand is being done from some other place instead of the allotted mines. For instance, against the valid Gajapura mine, sand excavation is being done from other areas. Owing to illegal sand mining, rural roads worth crores of rupees are getting damaged.

Replying to this, minister of state Dilip Ahirwar said around 45 complaints were received in Gwalior district and of them 28 have been solved. Wherever complaints

are made, action is taken, the minister added. To contain the illegal sand mining, the government is constructing 40 electronic barriers in the areas having mines.

MLA Bhawar Singh Shekawat said that when the government officers go to stop the illegal mining, they are killed using bulldozers and there are many cases in this regard.

Such is the situation of the sand and mineral mafia that it is not bothered about the government, nor administration. He alleged that in Dhar district, one former minister was involved in illegal mining and evaded royalty of Rs 4 crore.

No permission to dolomite mines after 2020: Ahirwar

Minister of state Dilip Ahirwar informed the assembly that since 2020, no permission has been given to dolomite mines. Before this, 41 mines were sanctioned. He was replying to the question of MLA Narayan Singh Patta, who raised the issue of dolomite mines of Mandla.
