

19 rescued from flood-hit areas of Raj

Five IAF helicopters deployed for rescue and relief works in rains-hit areas of state

Jaipur

Rescue operations on Tuesday resumed in rain-hit areas of Rajasthan's Jalore district where 19 people have been rescued from inundated areas. Seven persons, who had taken shelter on a tree, were airlifted by rescue teams. Relief operations are also taking place in Jalore, Sirohi and Pali districts which are facing flood-like situation due to incessant rainfall.

"Rescue operations resumed today (Tuesday) in Jalore where columns of the Army and NDRF teams have been deployed. One NDRF team is in Pali and two NDRF and one SDRF team is in Sirohi. Food packets and water bottles are being dispatched for villages which are surrounded by water," Hemant Gera, Secretary-Dis-

aster Management and Relief Department, told PTI. Jalore Collector Laxminarayan Soni said where airlifting people is not possible, boats of NDRF are being dispatched to rescue them. "Besides, packets of food and water bottles are being distributed in localities and villages which are inundated and efforts to rescue people from such locations is also underway," he said. Pali District Col-

lector Sudhir Kumar said nearly 150 people were rescued on Monday and the situation is now under control.

The IAF has deployed five helicopters for rescue and relief works in rains-hit areas of the state, Defence Spokesperson Lt Col Manish Ojha said. The MeT department has issued warning for heavy to very heavy rainfall in south-western and south-eastern, which covers Jodhpur and Udaipur division, during the next 24 hours.

Some areas in this region are already facing flood-like situation. Mout Abu in Sirohi recorded 733.6 mm rains followed by Jalore, Barmer, Phalodi (Jodhpur), Jodhpur city and Dabok where the rainfall measurement was 43, 41.6, 27.6, 26 and 18.7 mm rains. PTI

Salahuddin claims Hizbul can target anywhere in India: Govt

"Terrorist group Hizbul Mujahideen chief Syed Salahuddin is reported to have made claims that his outfit has the ability to hit targets anywhere in India at any time, Lok Sabha was informed on Tuesday. "Syed Salahuddin, supreme commander of the terrorist group - Hizbul Mujahideen, is reported to have made such a claim in the media," Minister of state for home Hansraj Ahir said in a written reply. Ahir said the militant group has been getting logistic support, including arms and ammunition, from Pakistan. "As per available information, some of the weapons and other items recovered from the encounter sites have the markings of the foreign countries," he said. Last months, Salahuddin was designated as a "global terrorist" by the United States. PTI

Shinde assumes AICC gen secy charge

Made in-charge of Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand

Maharashtra strongman and former Union Home Minister Sushil Kumar Shinde on Tuesday assumed the charge of All India Congress Committee general secretary in presence of a large number of veteran



party leaders and workers. Shinde, 76, has been appointed in place of Ambika Soni who had resigned a few days ago. Two States Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, of which she was in charge, have been given to Shinde to galvanise the party machinery. Himachal goes in for election later this year and experienced Shinde's role would be crucial there.

His induction into the AICC is also significant as it comes at a time when Dalit politics has surfaced in the country all over again with BJP playing a Dalit card. Shinde, a former Maharash-

tra Chief Minister, is a Dalit leader from Sholapur and was AICC general Secretary in 1996 after which he became governor of AP and CG. He was also in charge general secretary of Madhya Pradesh when Congress was in power in MP. After the UPA formed Government at the Centre in 2004, he held important portfolios such as power and home in Sr Manmohan Singh's ministry.

An unassuming and ever smiling leader, Shinde said his focus would be HP where he would try to help win the party at the hustings.

A host of leaders including AICC treasurer Motilal Vora, Rajya Sabha leader Anand Sharma, Janardan Dwivedi, Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Vir Bhadra Singh, PCC chief Sukhendra Singh, MP Congress leader Manohar Bothra, Telengana Congress leader G N Reddy, All India Women's Congress leader and film star Nagma and a large number of Congress workers and district officers from Maharashtra were present when he took the charge of office. It was after a long time that the AICC office here saw hectic activities and some enthusiasms among workers, pointed out a Delhi Congress leader.

TN CM meets Modi; seeks exemption from NEET

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister K Palaniswami on Tuesday met Prime Minister Narendra Modi and sought exemption for the state from the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test. "The chief minister insisted that exemption from NEET for Tamil Nadu should be given considering the welfare of the students of the state," said an official release quoting what transpired at the two leaders' meeting. Palaniswami's meeting with Modi comes amid ministerial delegations from the state meeting and discussing the matter with the top echelons of the Central government since last Thursday.

His meeting also assumes significance as the opposition, especially DMK, has been training its guns at both the Centre and the state government on the issue. On July 20, state ministers had met Modi and Union ministers for Health and HRD, J P Nadda and Prakash Javadekar, respectively, on NEET exemption. They had then submitted a memorandum with the prime minister seeking presidential approval for the two bills passed recently by the state assembly aimed at exempting the state from NEET and pending with the Centre. Modi displeased over BJP members' absence from Houses

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday expressed his displeasure over BJP members' absence from the both Houses of Parliament leading to trouble or embarrassment for the government.

Modi's remarks came here during weekly BJP parliamentary party meeting just after Parliamentary Affairs Minister Ananth Kumar and his junior Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi's reference to incidents and problems arising out of lack of quorum. In his response, the Prime Minister said that "he was worried and not satisfied with members' percentage of presence in houses," according to a BJP MP.

The government had to face an embarrassing situation in the Rajya Sabha last week when a bill on jurisdiction and settlement of maritime claims could not be taken up due to lack of quorum.

Modi also called upon the BJP MPs to observe fortnight programmes of Sankalp Yatra and hold Tiranga Yatra in their constituencies to celebrate 70th Independence Day.

Over 10,000 acres of defence land under encroachment: Govt

New Delhi

Around 10,220 acres of defence land is under encroachment across the country, including by various agencies of the central and state governments, the Rajya Sabha was informed today. Replying to a question, minister of state for defence Subhash Bhamre said various measures are being taken to remove encroachments from defence land.

Defence land to the extent of approximately 10,220 acres is presently under encroachment by various agencies of the central and state governments as well as by public sector undertakings, slum dwellers and private persons, he said. To a question on private defence industry, Bhamre said since the opening of the defence sector in 2001, the government has issued 342 industrial licenses to 205 Indian companies. "Adequate safety and security procedures would need to be put in place by the licensee. The companies shall comply with the security guidelines applicable to them based on the security categorisation indicated in the licence," he said. The minister said defence items produced by such companies will primarily be sold to the ministry of defence. "However, they can also be sold to other government entities under the control of ministry of home affairs, public sector undertakings, state governments and other different licensee companies, without the approval of department of defence production," he said. PTI

RJD-JDU crisis in Bihar

Nitish sets deadline for Tejaswhi

Chief minister expects his deputy to resign by Friday

The political drama in Bihar appears to have reached its final leg with JDU party sources saying that Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has conveyed to his deputy Tejaswhi Yadav that he expects his resignation before the state assembly convenes on Friday.

According to JDU sources, the CM has given enough time to Tejaswhi to present evidences that CBI raids against him for his alleged involvement in a corruption case, was a result of political witch hunt by the BJP. "It has already been 3 weeks since the FIR was registered against Tejaswhi and till now, as was expected from him, he has not presented any substantial proof regarding his innocence. The CM has given him enough time.

Nitish cannot be allowed to be seen as someone who is turning a blind eye to corruption, the RJD should know this", a senior JDU party source said.

Nitish, who was in Delhi to take part in the swearing in ceremony of new President, Ram Nath Kovind, told reporters in his first state-



ment since the political drama in Bihar, that "whatever was happening in Patna between the RJD and JDU was for everyone to see and figure out".

Earlier in the day, Lalu Prasad Yadav, the president of RJD, called a meeting of the party leaders, in which it was decided that the party cannot allow Tejaswhi to resign as this would give a wrong message to the voters who had supported the RJD.

The Congress, which is the 3rd party in the grand alliance, has been trying to stop Nitish from removing Tejaswhi from the cabinet, albeit unsuccessfully. Last week Nitish met Congress party Vice president Rahul Gandhi and told him that he cannot let Tejaswhi continue in the cabinet.

JDU party sources said that the party was ready for a by-election in case the RJD pulls out of the government and the BJP plays a hard ball on the question of offering JDU support.

AIADMK turns table on DMK over 'horse trading' taunt

Ruling AIADMK on Tuesday hit out at arch rival DMK for its horse trading taunt against the Palaniswami regime, alleging it was the M Karunanidhi-led party that had indulged in such acts to save its 'minority' government in 2006-11.

Referring to the oft repeated allegation of DMK Working President M K Stalin that the AIADMK government was a "horse trading regime", the ruling party's mouthpiece "Namadhu MGR" said the DMK then had 95 MLAs in the 234-member assembly and ran a "minority government".

"It is them (DMK) who did shameless politics to bring majority for the minority regime by indulging in horse trading with Tirupur Govindasamy and S Ve Shekar who won on an AIADMK ticket from Mylapore," said the Tamil daily, perceived to have the backing of AIADMK Deputy General Secretary TTV Dhinakaran.

CPI (M) Tirupur MLA C Govindasamy, who had hobbled with DMK leaders, was expelled from the party for anti-party activities and he later joined the DMK in 2010. Actor-politician Shekar was expelled from AIADMK in 2009 following differences with party chief late J Jayalalithaa. He functioned as an "unattached member" since then and joined BJP after a brief stint in Congress.

During 2006-11, though DMK did not have numbers to make up majority on its own, it had the support of 34 Congress MLAs and AIADMK had 61 MLAs. Contrasting the past with the present situation, the party mouthpiece said the AIADMK now had a majority with 122 MLAs. In a veiled reference to former Chief Minister O Panneerselvam-led faction, the party in a conciliatory note said "those who are joining and who will be joining belong to the same family. All contested on the same symbol (Two-leaves)." V C Arukuttu, MLA, a loyalist of Panneerselvam, recently joined Chief Minister K Palaniswami faction.

The AIADMK daily also trained its guns on Stalin for ridiculing Palaniswami as playing to the tunes of the Centre. PTI

36 attacks on Amarnath yatra in 27 years, 53 pilgrims killed

New Delhi

As many as 53 pilgrims have been killed in 36 terror attacks on the annual Amarnath yatra in the last 27 years, the Lok Sabha was informed on Tuesday. "From 1990 till date, 36 terrorist attacks have been reported on Amarnath yatra in which 53 were killed and 167 were injured," Minister of state for home Hansraj Ahir said in reply to a written question.

Ahir said all possible arrangements are being made by the Jammu and Kashmir government with the help of the Centre to strengthen the pilgrimage's security.

In the latest terror attack that took place on July 10, seven pilgrims were killed in Anantnag district of Jammu and Kashmir. One injured pilgrim succumbed to her injuries later.

Replying to another question, he said the duration and schedule of the pilgrimage is based on the decision taken by the Shri Amarnathji Shrine Board every year. The duration of the yatra is decided by the extent of snowfall in the preceding winter and the date on which Raksha Bandhan falls, when it is traditionally concluded, he said.

Therefore, the minister said, the duration of the pilgrimage varies from year to year. In 2017, the pilgrimage commenced on June 29 and will culminate on Raksha Bandhan which falls on August 7. "As such, the 2017 yatra is of 40 days. In 2016, it commenced on July 2 and concluded on August 18, and therefore, it was of 48 days," he said. PTI
