

# No death of shiksha mitras during protests: UP govt

The Uttar Pradesh government informed the Legislative Council on Friday that there had been no death of 'shiksha mitras' or teaching assistants during their protests over various demands.

The Samajwadi Party legislator, on a supplementary question, said he had information that 104 'shiksha mitras' or teaching assistants for primary classes in government schools had died during the protests and asked if the government would confirm the list and give compensation.

# Muzaffarnagar authorities against withdrawal of riots cases

District authorities are not in favour of withdrawal of the cases, mostly against political leaders, related to the Muzaffarnagar riots of 2013 in which over 60 people were killed and over 40,000 rendered homeless, official sources said here on Friday.

# Now Modi suggests 'lunch pe charcha'

After the "chai pe charcha" campaign during the 2014 Lok Sabha polls, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday asked his party MPs to hold "lunch pe charcha" to spread the good points of the Union Budget 2018-19 among the people.

The Prime Minister's suggestion came at a BJP Parliamentary party meeting where party chief Amit Shah described Congress President Rahul Gandhi's behaviour as "undemocratic" and suggested ways to counter his criticism of the Rafale fighter deal.

Sources present at the meeting said the Prime Minister described the Union budget as positive for the middle class and farmers and asked them to discuss its benefits among the masses.

Intervening in Shah's speech, Modi described how he held discussions with party cadres in his parliamentary constituency Varanasi over lunch by bringing his own tiffin.

The sources said Modi asked the MPs to hold such 'lunch pe charcha' by bringing their own tiffin in every assembly segment of their constituency during the Budget Session break.

At the meeting, two booklets containing the Prime Minister's speech at the World Economic Forum in Davos and Shah's speech at various platforms were distributed among the MPs.

# Renuka spares PM, takes on MoS Rijju

Instead of targeting Prime Minister Modi for an uncharitable remark on Wednesday, senior Congress MP Renuka Chowdhury on Friday moved a privilege notice in the Rajya Sabha against Union Minister of State Kiren Rijju for mocking her on the social media and suggesting by innuendo that PM had compared her with Surpanakha, the evil genius in the Ramayana TV series.

Though the PM made no such comparison and merely said that Renuka's guffaw had reminded him of similar derisive laughter in the TV serial Ramayan, Rijju mudied the waters by posting on his Facebook account a TV serial clip of Surpanakha laughing her head off.

Without mentioning Rijju's name, since he is a member of the other House (Lok Sabha), Samajwadi Party member Naresh Agarwal raked up the issue in the Rajya Sabha through a point of order to suggest that the member should apologise for his nasty conjecture in the social media.
